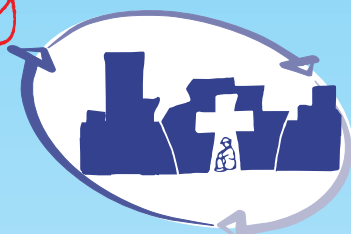

The International Consultation on Urban Ministry which coincides with the Soccer World Cup will be hosted from 30 June - 2 July in Pretoria, City of Tshwane, by the Institute for Urban Ministry. This biennial consultation has become an important meeting place for people who are deeply committed to their cities, who seek to reflect on the work they do from a faith perspective and are committed to work in partnership for transformed cities.

Our theme for this year is *Fair Play: Celebrating & Imagining Cities of Justice*. It will reflect specifically on the role of the church, faith communities and ordinary citizens in working towards local and global urban justice, i.e. socio-political, economic, environmental, generational, gender and spatial. The Consultation will introduce the stories of experienced urban practitioners, living miracles of hope, through plenary sessions, workshops, urban excursions, exhibitions and times for worship and celebration.
